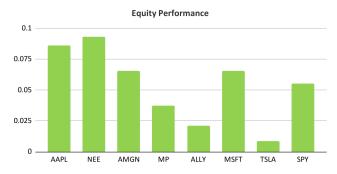

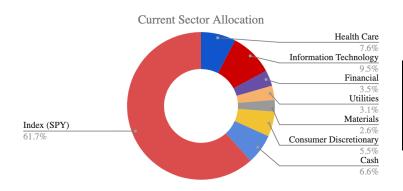

NextEra Energy (NEE)

Apple Inc. (AAPL)



Thesis: World's largest generator of renewable energy and world leader in battery storage with strong growth prospects as these industries continue to grow rapidly.

- Purchased at favorable price compared to 52 week high.
- Consistent returns higher than S&P 500 and peer utility companies.
- Strong market position with capital intensive barriers to entry for competitors.

Thesis: AAPL's ecosystem, high customer retention rates, and expending addressable market.

- Stable replacement cycles from 5G expansion and robust free cash flow aiding growth initiatives/ shareholder
- The ability to take share at the high end of the China market.
- Services will benefit from rising paid subscribers.

Tesla (TSLA)

Ally Financial (ALLY)



Thesis: Tesla is the world's largest producer of electric vehicles and is well positioned to be the biggest winner through incentives provided by the inflation reduction act.

- Uniquely positioned to provide value to consumers through vertical integration of products.
- Purchased at 52-week low suggesting good value given growth prospects.
- Strong and consistent growth in revenue and net income.

Thesis: Ally's valuation is attractive compared to its peers. The company's P/E ratio is lower than the industry average, indicating that it is undervalued relative to its peers.

- Net income almost tripled from 2020 to 2021.
- Ally has a healthy balance sheet with low levels of debt and strong liquidity.
